

Publication requirements for scientific articles

Content Organisation:

- Abstract;
- Introduction (relevance of the topic, purpose, objectives);
- Theoretical framework of the research and methods;
- Results and discussion;
- Conclusions /generalisation;
- References;
- Abstract (in English). The abstract of an English article is presented in Lithuanian.

Typesetting Requirements:

- The recommended scope of the article is maximum 6 A4 size pages;
- Text editor - MS Word; Font - Times New Roman;
- Paper size A4, margins: at the top and at the bottom – 2 cm, on the left and on the right – 2.5 cm;
- Title of the article – typed in bold capital letters, font 14 pt, centred;
- Name and surname of the author(s)– typed in bold, italic, small letters, font 14 pt, centred;
- Name of the institution – typed in bold, italic, small letters, font 14 pt, centred;
- The main text of the article – typed in small letters, font 14 pt, with first line 1.5 cm from left margin, line spacing - single, aligned with both the left and right (justified);
- Citation of authors - links to references in the article text are given in square brackets [].
- Equations are numbered and inserted with Equation Editor;
- Numbers and titles of the tables are written in small letters, font 14 pt, centred, spacing before and spacing after set to 12 pt;
- Numbers and titles of the images are written below the image in small letters font 14 pt, centred, spacing before and spacing after set to 12 pt;
- References are listed fully in the order they were cited in the text of the article.

Articles (with a review signed by a scientist in a related field) should be **submitted to** konferencija@atf.viko.lt

The submitted article must be accompanied by a **cover letter** that contains information about the author(s) (**Annex 1**).

Articles will be published in the publication "Modern Technologies for Sustainable Environment 2018".

The list of references must comply with the modified APA style guidelines.

With three or more authors, indicate only the first author followed by "et al." e.g.:
